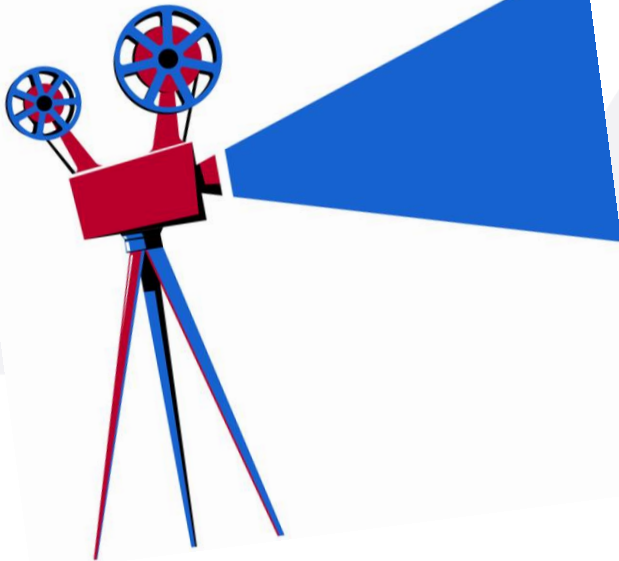





- ★ Immediate need on several key client projects


